

## How to apply for admission to UAM as an Erasmus student for 2015/2016

### Deadlines:

- From 1st to 31st May, for first semester and full academic year students
- 1st June to 31st October for second semester students

### Application Form (electronic application form)

This process comprises two steps:

1.Registration as user: you need to register as a UAM user to access online services. Click [here](#) for registering as a user, you will receive an email with your username and your password (please check your SPAM folder)

2.Application form: with the user name and password you were given when registering, you will log in the application form. Click [here](#) for completing the application form. Important: confirm with your home university the UAM faculty or school you have been selected for.

### Specific admission requirements for Master students

#### ➤ Language requirements

In order for incoming students from the mobility programs to be admitted into our university (UAM), it is necessary to have a language certificate that proves that you have at least a B2 level in the Spanish language. It is preferable if this certificate is the D.E.L.E. (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera, which translates to Spanish Diploma as a Second Language). Very exceptionally, for those that do not have a language certificate, we will evaluate the student's knowledge of the Spanish language through a personal interview given by the coordinators of the Master course that the student wishes to apply for.

#### ➤ Previous formation requirements

It is necessary for the student to have a Psychology degree or similar, and to have completed Master level courses or to be currently taking courses related to those that are available in the Master's degree that they wish to enter in. In these cases, we will need the student to present the necessary documentation to prove this.

If there are any doubts, any clarification or more information is needed; the coordinator of the Master will be in contact with the student.

The language and previous formation requirements are generally the same for all of the official Master courses offered at the Faculty of Psychology.

The documents required need to be sent at [ori.psicologia@uam.es](mailto:ori.psicologia@uam.es). The deadline for sending these documents is from May 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>.

➤ Observations and specific entry requirements of each Masters Degree

*Health Psychology Master*

For the course named "Practicum", the student must present a certificate proving a C1 level in the Spanish language and have completed 60 ETCS credits in a Health Psychology Master.

For the T.F.M. (End of Master Thesis) related to the Practicum the entry requirements are the same for both courses.

For the End of Master Thesis in research, it is necessary for the student to have a certificate of Spanish language proving at least a C1 level. Preferably we wish for this certificate to be the D.E.L.E. (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera, which translates to Spanish Diploma as a Second Language). It is also necessary to have a recommendation letter from the academic supervisor supporting the proposal that the student has for the End of Master Thesis.

*Psychology of Education Master*

No student can take the Practicum course when this has a professionalizing purpose but it is possible to do so if the Practicum is research motivated, provided that in this case, this possibility would be dependent on the prior knowledge, interests and research skills of the applicant.

**Learning Agreement**

The deadline for sending the Learning Agreement at [ori.psicologia@uam.es](mailto:ori.psicologia@uam.es) is May 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>. The valid Learning Agreement document is the Erasmus+ specific document.

In case you would also like to take course from other faculties, bear in mind that at least 51% of your subjects must belong to the UAM faculty or school in which you are going to study.
